## HOUSEHOLD CLEANING

- Appliances: Use ¼ tsp to 1 pint of water. Leaves refrigerators odor free and sanitary
- Aquariums: Use 1 tsp. of SWFF Cleaner solution. Rinse thoroughly.
- Automatic Dishwashers: Use ½ tsp. per load. Keeps dishwasher clean and drains open.
- Bathroom Fixtures: Use ¼ tsp. to 1 pint of water. Great for bathroom tile!
- Ceramic Tile: Use ½ tsp. per gallon of warm water. Damp mop, no rinsing necessary
- Concrete & Mortar Mix: Use ½ oz. to 1 gallon of water. Makes cement and mortar spread easier and smoother. Sets harder
- Diapers: Use ½ tsp. of SWFF Cleaner and drop of SGC to pail of water. Eliminates odors in the washroom when diapers must stand
- Dishes: Use 1 tsp. in the dishpan. Fill dirty pans with water; add 1.2 tsp. SWFF Cleaner and let stand to loosen stuck particles.
- Dusting: Squeeze sponge out of solution of ¼ tsp. to 1 pint of water. With almost dry sponge, wipe off dust, fingerprints, candy spots, etc. Or, use spray bottle and clean cloth. Everything disappears from furniture, leaving the wax finish beautifully bright and non-magnetic making it unnecessary to dust so often.
- Fine Fabrics: Use 1 or 2 tsp to one basin of water. For spots, apply a drop or two directly on the spot and press in with thumb. Immerse garment in cold water solution of 1 tsp per gallon of water, let stand a few minutes, then rinse by squeezing water through. Lay to dry
- Fish Odors: Use 1 Tbsp per quart of water. SWFF Cleaner cleaning solutions work wonders around boats, docks and other "fishy" areas.

Fruits:	Use ¼ tsp. to 1 pint of water. Wash & rinse. Removes residues of poisonous sprays and grime of handling/transport.
Frying Vats:	Use ½ cup to 3 gallons of water. Boil for 5 minutes, stirring constantly. Dissipates stubborn crusts without damage to vats.
General Cleaning:	Use 1 tsp. to 1 quart of warm water. Cleans kitchen doors, woodwork, walls, ceilings, etc.
Glass:	Use 2 drops in 16 oz. spray bottle of water. Wipe dry with paper towel. Do not use too much SWFF Cleaner or glass will smear.
Knives:	Use a few drops on cutting stone for sharpening knives. Keep moist and add as needed. Doesn't clog stone which is very important in sharpening tools. Stone rinses free of residue.
Laminate Floors:	Use ½ tsp. per gallon of warm water. Damp mop, no rinsing necessary.
Lettuce:	Use 2 or 3 drops in bowl of water with lettuce to make crisp.
Mirrors:	Use 2 drops in 16 oz. spray bottle of water. Wipe dry with paper towel. Do not use too much SWFF Cleaner or glass will smear.
Nylon Fabric:	Use 1 or 2 tsp to one basin of water. For spots, apply a drop or two directly on the spot and press in with thumb. Immerse garment in cold water solution of 1 tsp per gallon of water, let stand a few minutes, then rinse by squeezing water through. Lay to dry
Phonograph Records:	Use same solution as for glass. Clean with soft, dry cloth. Leaves no residual magnetism
Poster Paint on Windows:	Remove it with ½ tsp to a quart of warm water.
Silks:	Use 1 or 2 tsp to one basin of water. For spots, apply a drop or two directly on the spot and press in with thumb. Immerse garment in cold water solution of 1 tsp per gallon of water, let stand a few minutes, then rinse by squeezing water through. Lay to dry
Spot Remover:	Apply SWFF Cleaner directly to spotted area. Use a toothbrush or finer to rub SWFF Cleaner into area. Wipe off with damp cloth or rinse in basin of water. Good for coffee, lipstick, ink, grass, etc.
Spray Snow:	Remove it with ½ tsp to a quart of warm water.
Vegetables:	Use ¼ tsp. to 1 pint of water. Wash & rinse. Removes residues of poisonous sprays and grime of handling/transport.
Vinyl Floors:	Use ½ tsp. per gallon of warm water. Damp mop, no rinsing necessary

Wallpaper:	Excellent in removing wallpaper.
Windows:	Use 2 drops in 16 oz. spray bottle of water. Wipe dry with paper towel. Do not use too much SWFF Cleaner or glass will smear.
Wood Floors:	Use 1 Tbsp. per gallon of warm water. Damp cloth or mop, no rinsing necessary, very effective, yet safe. Leaves floor shining like new.
Woolens:	Use 1 or 2 tsp to one basin of water. For spots, apply a drop or two directly on the spot and press in with thumb. Immerse garment in cold water solution of 1 tsp per gallon of water, let stand a few minutes, then rinse by squeezing water through. Lay to dry

## PERSONAL USE

Bathing:	Use 2 tsp. to bathtub of water. Run water full force for suds. Does not no bathtub ring. Perfect for baby's bath; less alkaline than baby soap
Cleaning Hands:	Put a few drops in palm. Rub thoroughly over both hands and add a little water. Wash & rinse. Removes tobacco stains, onion & garlic odors.
Gum:	Use full strength to remove gum from skin or carpeting.
Poison Ivy & Oak:	Use SWFF Cleaner to bath in with water.
Protecting Hands:	Apply to hands, full strength, for lasting protection as an industrial skin guard. Great as invisible gloves before painting
Repellent:	Use full strength. Biting insects will not bite skin where SWFF Cleaner has been applied.
Shaving:	Apply full strength to face and add water to make lather.
Show Cleaner:	Use 2 drops on a wet cloth. It will not remove wax. Shine with a dry cloth.

## AUTOMOTIVE

Automobile Radiator:	Use 1 Tbsp to radiator full of water or anti-freeze. This prevents rust.
Battery Terminals:	Use ½ tsp to pint of water. Spray on battery terminal and let soak 2 minutes. Clean with a wire brush.
Engines:	Use ½ oz. to 1 gallon of water to clean engine. Will not affect paint, gaskets or insulating material. Best results can be achieved when the engine is hot for fastest drying of the ignition system.

Washing: Use 1 Tbsp to 1 gallon of water. Wash small areas at a time and hose off. Wiping dry is not necessary. Wipe windshield, windows, and chrome with towels after rinsing. Bugs and road grime float away.

## MISCELLANEOUS

Air Filters: Use 1 tsp to 1 quart of warm water. Air filters are cleaned with excellent results leaving them free of dirt, oil or chemical residue.

House Plants: Use a few drops of cleaner. Water plants and they will flourish. Use it to wipe leaves also.

Humidifiers: Use 3 or 4 drops in water to prevent rust and scum

Ironing: A few drops in steam iron keep the jets and interior clean.

Plumbing: Will keep pipes open and clean when used regularly. It emulsifies grease and can eliminate cleaning of grease traps.
